
And This is Global Warming in Action....


I'm certain that many of you will have enjoyed the last few weeks of sunshine and intense heat, but not me. The countryside hasn't enjoyed it either. The virtually frost free early spring has meant a bumper crop of fruit on the trees, but the lack of rain is threatening the harvest as the developing fruit need water as much and probably more than sunshine.

The stress that plants are under will almost certainly exacerbate the spread of pests and diseases, which in turn will threaten the production of crops and drive up costs. We probably won't see the results until the autumn when supermarket prices will rise.

This is a global problem, Sixteen of the seventeen warmest years in the 136 years records have been kept, all have occurred since 2001, with the exception of 1998. The year 2016 ranks as the warmest on record.

What can we do? Not a lot except pray that America sees sense and signs up to the Paris accord on climate change. And maybe learn how to do a rain dance.



Hen Street Leat

The raised pavement and integral conduit, steps and ramps of Hen street were probably built C18 and C19 with earlier origins and is Grade 2 listed.

During the Musical Gardens weekend someone commented on the poor state of the leat and the heavy weed growth. It was suggested that a working group could be created to keep the area neat and tidy and preserve a rich example of Bradninch's early heritage.



I have made some enquiries and hope the "Payback team" can come back and clear the greenery which will help enormously but once cleared we need to remove as much of the accumulated silt as we can and then find somebody with the necessary certification to spray the cobbles which are lifting due to large root weeds.

Is there a friendly, local chap with a sprayer we can call upon the help keep the cobbles clear?

Silverton Street Market

Time flies and Silverton Annual Street Market (5th August) will soon be upon us. There is a wonderful array of stalls already booked; arts, crafts, plants, home baking, as well as traditional and exotic cuisines and a Pimms and Prosecco bar.

Exe Valley Brewery will be selling their specially crafted Top of the Hops golden hoppy brew and there will even be someone selling alcoholic icecream. There are still one or two spaces left and it is not too late to have a go yourself at showcasing your talents and wares.

The theme this year is 'music' and throughout the day there are buskers playing, an open piano in the Methodist Church, The Somerset Paddies playing in the Lamb and Junk instrument making on the Old Hall Site. Also on the old hall site are Crediton Town Band, Silverton Community Choir, Global Harmony and Lindy Hop Crew and not forgetting Silverton Sings.

In the evening there are 3 live bands playing in the Community Hall headlined by Basher Tate along with a hog roast and licensed bar. Tickets are on sale at the Spa shop for just \pounds 5 or \pounds 7 on the night.

An important part of the day is the children's activities and entertainment and this year there is a whole host of activities to amuse and delight them, including a magician, a juggler, a ventriloquist as well as a bouncy castle, rodeo challenge, face painting and glitter tattoos.

The excitement builds towards the end of the day as the men, and women, dig in their heels in the traditional Tug of War. Just take a moment to look around at the faces in the crowd if you want to see sheer delight and engagement.

Street Market is very much a community event and is an important part of village life which brings people together from Silverton and surrounding villages to eat, laugh and play. It is run entirely by volunteers with money being raised for local groups and organisations, including this year money being raised for the 'Silverton Night Landing Project. The streets are traffic free and the atmosphere amazing.





Keep Your Pets Safe in Hot Weather

The recent heat wave has take its toll on most of us, but while we can take steps to keep cool, it is important to take care of our pets.

Be careful to avoid heat stroke – watch for signs of overheating such as excessive panting, drooling, coordination problems, vomiting and/or diarrhoea and collapse. If worried, call your vet for advice.


